

Synopsis - a summing up of the discussions and conclusions of the ASISNA conference of July 1-2-3 2006...

We met together to discuss the possibility of providing for the fellowship of Narcotics Anonymous a new Tradition-based service board/committee. In accordance with the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Traditions we came to the following conclusions:

1. Many Groups and members want services not currently offered to NA due to broad compromise of several of our Traditions, particularly 2-4-6-7-&9
2. We can provide those services if we allow the Groups that care to create them the opportunity to, and configure our proposal with a clear line of Direct Responsibility
3. The following two pages represent our initial proposal as trusted servants of our groups
4. We will distribute these ideas and proposals to the groups we belong to as well as any other interested groups and members for Group Conscience
5. In September at the 2006 History and Traditions Retreat in Ohio we will meet again to collect the results of this first group conscience regarding this issue and follow the instruction of those we serve

You will receive several e-mails and/or letters concerning this including full documentation and complete accountability please review the proposals through your group's conscience and reply to us as soon as you can – we believe a 2/3 majority of those groups involved should be required for action

...e-mail announcement opt-in lists...  
...experience on how groups and members can safely contribute to new and open NA Literature development projects, keeping this protected from profiteering and theft.

2) An entity to legally hold copyrights both temporarily during development, and permanently assuring use of material compliant with the 12 Traditions...and to define contributions by individuals as charitable donations...and Accountability – regular publication of all finances

3) A conference for the periodic collection of the conscience of those Groups we serve...etc...

**ASISna**

**Purpose:**

- To serve as requested by groups of NA. To provide the services that the groups of NA want and nothing else.
- To act as a central communication resource for NA groups, members and other directly responsible service boards and committees
- To build a communication system for the N.A. fellowship ... a support network.
- To restore understanding of the 12 traditions and NA History. And to reform all NA services into compliance with the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup> Traditions and enhancement of all Traditions.
- **ASISna** will not make decisions for the N.A. Groups it serves ...if there is no group conscience or no clear majority on a question ASISna will postpone action till its Direct Responsibility is defined.
- No trusted servants [officers] of the **ASISna** service committee will have voting power. Only the groups will have voting power. NA Groups decide the course and responsibility of **ASISna** services. **ASISna** services are funded fully by direct contributions from those we serve (per seventh Tradition)
